- Behavior management strategies
- Mitigating health & safety concerns
- Stabilizing & supporting youth & meeting their needs

Survey Results

- 32 surveys were collected from case presenters (80.6% of sessions)
- 443 post session surveys were collected from attendees

- Specific recommendations
- Availability of multi-disciplinary experts
- General discussion & processing
